# Aberdeen City Council Anderson Drive Air Quality Management Area Order 2011 (Nitrogen Dioxide and Particles $(PM_{10})$ )

## Amendment to Order Designating an Air Quality Management Area

Whereas Aberdeen City Council ("the Council"), having caused to be conducted a review and assessment of air quality in Aberdeen, is satisfied that the air quality objectives in respect of Nitrogen Dioxide and Particles (PM<sub>10</sub>) specified in The Air Quality (Scotland) Regulations 2000 (as amended by the Air Quality (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 2002) are not likely to be met in the area described in the schedule below for reasons both of the current and projected exceedance of the objectives.

The Council in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 83(1) of the Environment Act 1995, hereby makes the following Amendment Order to the Air Quality Management Area designated in December 2008.

## IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:-

- 1. The area shaded red on the attached map which forms part of this Amendment Order, and described in the schedule below, shall be known as the Aberdeen City Council City Anderson Drive Air Quality Management Area (Nitrogen Dioxide and Particles (PM<sub>10</sub>)).
- 2. The Air Quality Management Area be specific to Nitrogen Dioxide by virtue of likely exceedances of the annual mean objective and to Particles by virtue of likely exceedances of the annual mean objective and 24 hour objective.
- 3. The Order be cited as the Aberdeen City Council Air Quality Management Area (Nitrogen Dioxide and Particles ( $PM_{10}$ )) Order 2011.
- 4. The Order shall come into force on 9 December 2011 and shall remain in force until varied or revoked by subsequent Order.
- 5. A copy of the Order and the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at Environmental Protection Services, Housing and Environment, Business Hub 15, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor Marischal College, Broad Street, Aberdeen AB10 1AB.

## Schedule

The area shaded red on the attached plan which incorporates the following is declared to be the designated area:

- (1) All of Anderson Drive, from the Bridge of Dee, including Haudigan Roundabout
- (2) Part of Great Northern Road, from 815 Great Northern Road to Auchmill Road
- (3) Part of Auchmill Road, from Great Northern Road to the junction with Howes Road
